Sunday, November 2 is All Saints Sunday. This is a time to remember those saints among us who have died since last All Saints Sunday. Each service we have will be different from the other. Pick the one or two weekly services that fulfill your spiritual needs. And help build our church into the fortress and stronghold it is meant to be.



Greetings Salem Family,

As mentioned briefly at the annual congregation meeting, we once again are experiencing AC maintenance issues that must be dealt with. One of the original units as well as the balcony unit have gone out. We are currently cooling the entire Sanctuary and Gathering Place with our newest unit installed 1.5 yrs ago. We will need to hold a called congregation meeting to move forward with the replacement of



the two AC/Heating units. It is the recommendation of the Salem Church Council that we vote to replace both units as soon as possible. The bid to replace the units is from Lakeway, the company who replaced the third unit 1.5 yrs ago. The cost will be \$52,292.00. Our Trustees also obtained a bid of \$5,300.00 to cover the construction, materials and labor to repair the wall and gable that will have to be torn down to remove the old and install the new units. The total cost of this project will be roughly \$58,992.00.

As we near the end of the year and many are looking to donate to charities, we ask that you prayerfully consider donating toward Salem's Building Fund and this much needed project. Salem has been so blessed and we are thankful to be able to handle unexpected maintenance issues of this type. It is because of your generosity that the blessing continues.
